## Applying the Hot Fix

Run the CreateOracleViews.sql script on your Sage SalesLogix database. The script must be run as the sys user.

### To run

1. Extract the contents of the **SLX\_v751\_HF12.zip** file to a temporary folder.
2. Open Oracle SQL \*Plus Worksheet or SQL Developer.
3. On the **File** menu, click **Open**.
4. Browse to the **CreateOracleViews.sql** script.  
The script is located in the folder where you extracted the hot fix files.
5. To load the script into the Query section, click **Open**.
6. To run the script, click **Execute**.
